Your Wedding at Goodenough

Tucked away on leafy Mecklenburgh Square in the heart of Bloomsbury our Grade 2* listed building is a unique space that brings together tranquillity and the outdoors with a central London location. This hidden gem is the perfect setting for your wedding ceremony, celebration or both!

Only a 5-minute walk from Russell Square station or a 12-minute walk from King's Cross and Chancery Lane station's, we are easily accessible for guests who are travelling nationally or internationally to share your special day with you.

Formed by Frederick Goodenough in 1930 and refurbished in 2014, Goodenough College is a postgraduate residence and educational trust. Each of our 4 licensed rooms have a personality and history of their own from oak panelled walls to high vaulted ceilings.

The building wraps around a beautifully manicured quadrangle garden with cloistered walkways running the southern length of the garden. Our north and south arches, with cobbled floors and wrought iron gates make for a grand entrance and photogenic confetti exit.

We have a range of reception options from a formal seated wedding breakfast to a relaxed canapés reception or a BBQ in the garden Quad.

The characterful features of our venue make for variety of photogenic backdrops and our in-house caterers offer delicious food & drink packages with bespoke options available.

After a day of making memories to treasure our 4-star accommodation at The Goodenough On Mecklenburgh Square is only a two minute walk-away. This 65-ensuite bedroom club house situated across 5 Georgian townhouses is the perfect accommodation solution for any guests travelling into London for your big day. It also allows you to share an actual breakfast (or brunch!) together the following morning maximising on quality time with your loved ones.

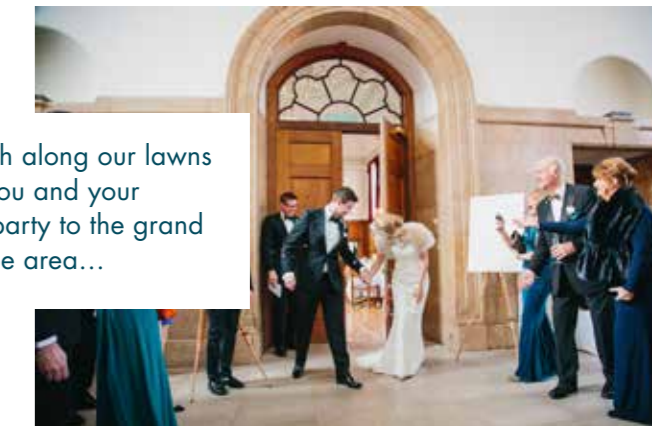
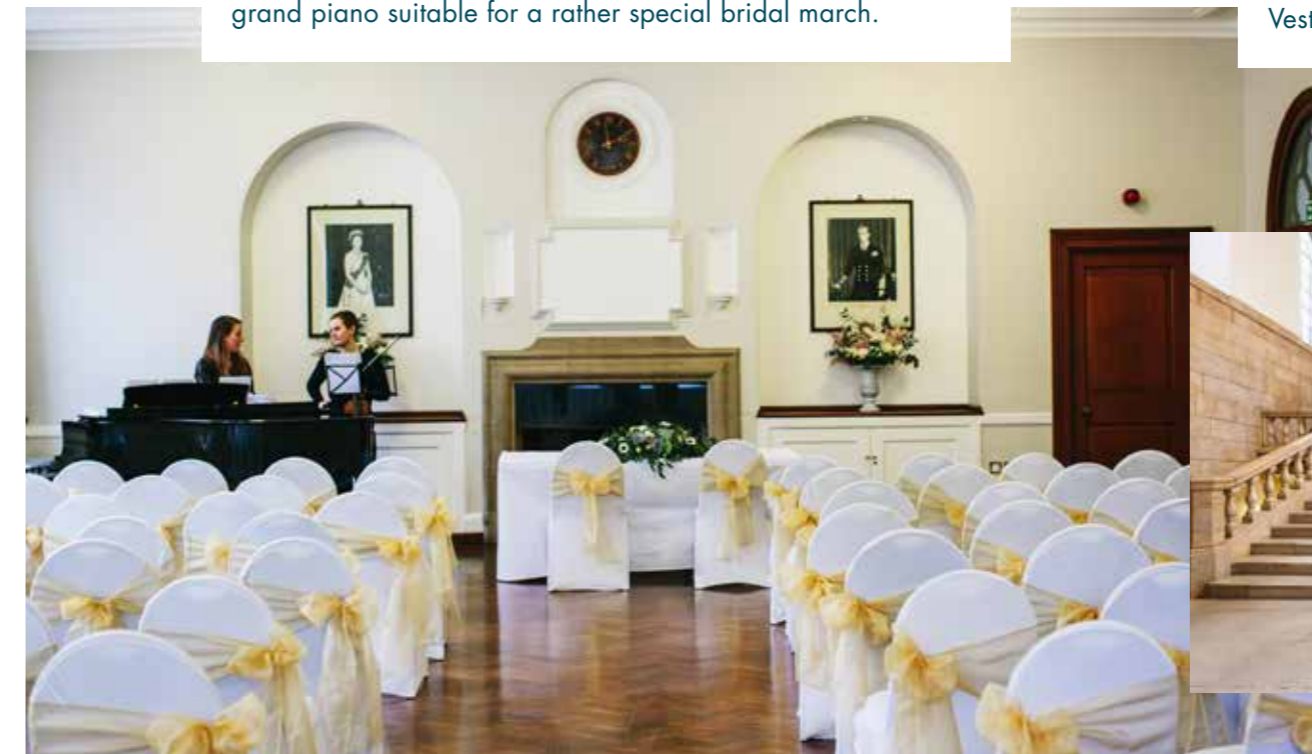

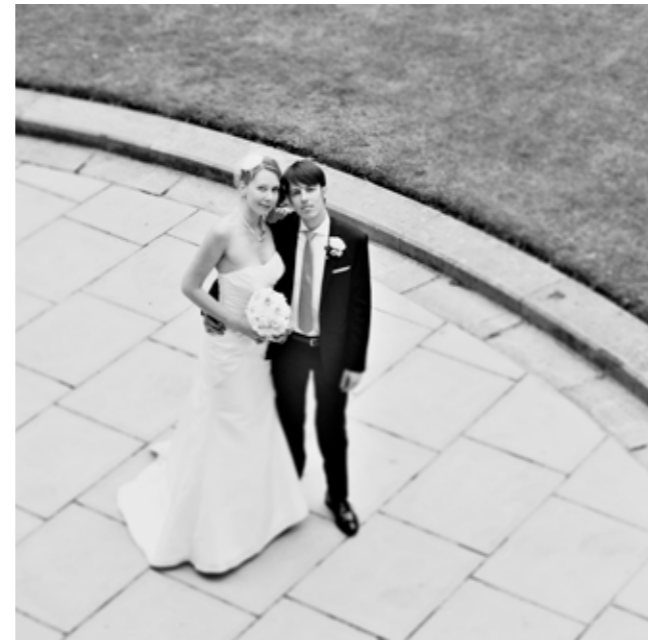

Intimate Wedding Ceremonies

Small Common Room

Up to 30 guests

This classical, characterful room with dual aspect windows has a unique charm ideal for an intimate ceremony of up to 30 guests.

You will also have 1-hour access to the Garden Quad following your ceremony to take photos and enjoy a celebratory glass of prosecco.

A separate room will be provided for you to meet with the registrar prior to the ceremony.

The hire fee for a ceremony only booking in this room is **£635+VAT**.

Mid-Size Wedding Ceremonies

Churchill Room

Up to 70 guests

Our Churchill Room, as the name implies, is named after Sir Winston Churchill in honour of the Officers' Club, which was housed in this room during WWII. It is a beautiful oak panelled room perfect for ceremonies with up to 70 guests.

You will also have 1-hour access to the Garden Quad following your ceremony to take photos and enjoy a celebratory glass of prosecco.

A separate room will be provided for you to meet with the registrar prior to the ceremony.

The hire fee for a ceremony only booking in this room is **£1300+VAT**.

Large Common Room

Up to 120 guests

Designed by Sir Herbert Baker, our London House Large Common Room is our most popular space for a ceremony, holding up to 120 guests for a ceremony. It even houses a grand piano.

You will also have 1-hour access to the Garden Quad following your ceremony to take photos and enjoy a celebratory glass of prosecco.

A separate room will be provided for you to meet with the registrar prior to the ceremony.

The hire fee for a ceremony only booking in this room is **£2000+VAT**.

Grand Wedding Ceremonies

High vaulted ceilings, oak panelled walls and a sweeping staircase to emerge from for your grand entrance this room can hold up to 250 guests for a wedding ceremony and even has the option of hiring our grand piano for the wedding march.

You will also have 1-hour access to the Garden Quad following your ceremony to take photos and enjoy a celebratory glass of prosecco.

A separate room will be provided for you to meet with the registrar prior to the ceremony.

White

Boatman's Drift Chenin Blanc
(included in the wedding catering package)
South Africa **(V)**

This grape arrived in the Cape of Good Hope with the Dutch settlers and continues to produce lime and honeyed aromas and flavours. No Oak.

Ca'Luca Pinot Grigio £18.00
Italy **(VG)**

Made from Pinot Grigio Grapes in Veneto in the North of Italy made in stainless steel for ultimate freshness and floral finish.

Whale Point Sauvignon Blanc £20.00
South Africa **(VG)**

Sauvignon Blanc takes on complex aromas of cut grass and melons when it is grown in the cool onshore wines of the Cape. The coldness gives the fresh lemon zest and the sun the ripeness – the perfect balance.

Picpoul de Pinet 'Trois Mats' £22.00
Languedoc, France **(VG)**

Piquepoul (sic) the grape is mainly grown in one small area of South of France. It has a ripe white peach and quince blossom aroma and is great on its own or with seafood.

Red

Whale Point Pinot Noir
(included in the wedding catering package)
South Eastern Australia **(V)**

Made from the Pinot Noir which has thin skins and therefore produces lighter and more fragrant reds. This one sings of Red fruits and violets and is perfect house drinking.

Hamilton Heights Shiraz £18.00
South Australia **(VG)**

Made from the Shiraz grape in South Australia – bold and cinnamon spicy with a soft tannins and a round supple finish. Bottled in lightweight glass in the UK to save the Carbon Footprint.

La Playa, Cabernet Sauvignon £20.00
Colchagua Valley, Chile **(VG)**

Grown on the sandy "beach like" banks for the Tinguiririca River that enjoys an exceptional climate that is perfect for growing balanced Cabernet Sauvignon. No Oak.

Doppio Passo Primitivo £22.00
Salento, Italy **(VG)**

Made from the Primitivo grape in the far south of Italy the skins are "double passed" for extra extraction of colour when making this wine.

Le Monde Prosecco Spumante
Venetto, Italy **(VG)** £27.00

A complex and charming Prosecco with ripe sunny citrus fruit and peaches with a fine fizz indicating quality.

Cremant de Loire Brut Amirault Loire Valley, France £33.00

(Fined with Casin)
Made from 100% Chenin Blanc but with rich yeasty flavours only achieved in the Method traditionnelle, the same method of production as Champagne but with a nicer price tag.

Ayala Brut Champagne £45.00
France **(V)**

The real deal - made in the village of Ay in Champagne with Chardonnay Pinot Noir and Pinot Meunier. Bollinger's little sister.

Rosé

Le Poussin Rosé £23.00
Provence, France **(V)**

Made in the south of France with a blend of three grapes. Very pale pink orange in colour and bone dry in style.

Organic/Biodynamic

Ladybird Chenin Blanc £21.00
South Africa **(VG)**

Straw gold colour and made with the Chenin Blanc this smooth white has more depth than the French but is still bone dry and made using sustainable agricultural techniques. Ladybirds do all the pest control.
